

25th United States Colored Trooper's Civil War Service to be Honored

#### At 1:00 pm on May 20, 2022 a ceremony will be held at the Kenton Cemetery to honor

#### SERGEANT HIRAM H. WHITE of the 25<sup>th</sup> United States Colored Troop

A lunch will follow at the Duncan Township Hall in Kenton.





#### ABOUT HIRAM H. WHITE

Hiram H. White was born in 1846 in Pennsylvania and served in the 25<sup>th</sup> United States Colored Troops during the Civil War. He was Honorably discharged as a Sergeant in 1865 and lived in Pennsylvania, Ohio, and Minnesota before moving to Kenton, Michigan where he worked as a barber until his death in 1917. The citizens of Kenton have placed a United States Flag on Hiram's grave for the past 104 years until recently, when sufficient evidence was obtained to order a Government Headstone for his grave.

A search on Ancestry.com located enlistment and discharge records for a Civil War Soldier by the name of Hiram White who served in the 25th United States colored Troops. Subsequent searches were able to locate United States Census records for Hiram White before and after the Civil War, but none of those records mentioned residency anywhere in Michigan.

Further investigation on Ancestry.com led to Ms. Shayne Davidson, a professional artist and amateur genealogist, who wrote a book about a recently re-discovered collection of rare civil-war-era photographs of 17 black Soldiers from Company G, 25<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment, United States Colored Troops. Sergeant Hiram H. White was one of these Soldiers, and Ms. Davidson was able to provide a document from her research showing the termination of the Civil War Pension for Hiram White upon his death on February 4, 1917 in Kenton, Michigan. This document was the final proof required to link Hiram White to the grave in Kenton, Michigan.


