## A SPECIAL MESSAGE FOR OTTAWA SHOPPER READERS

Dear Readers,

As long-time, local readers of the *Ottawa Shopper* know, there were several enterprising women before me who, starting in 1956, devoted decades of their time and attention to religiously publishing the *Ottawa Shopper* (also fondly referred to as *The Shopper*). Given that level of dedication, it is no surprise that the prior publishers neatly, sweetly, and *oh so* completely saved a copy of every edition published starting from September 1956. And recently, Teresa Miesbauer (publisher from 1990-2020) graciously shared those copies with me. I've only had time to read the first few years' worth of editions. So far, what I've seen and learned by reading the delicate, aged pages of the past is quite remarkable. With every turn of a page, I find interesting advertisements, announcements, and the like, all of which unintentionally teach a mini local history lesson and pique my interest to connect the dots to present-day locations, businesses, people, and events.

Looking at the earliest editions of *The Shopper*, through my eyes as the newest publisher, it is clear that this little gem of a printed tradition has always been a labor-intensive endeavor. I can personally attest that printing and delivering *The Shopper* to nearly 3,000 addresses to dozens of small towns and "locations" nestled in the Ottawa National Forest twice a month is no small feat.

In recent years (barring the brief publishing pause due to COVID), and since resuming publishing in May 2022, *The Shopper* pages have been mostly filled with paid advertisements from local and regional businesses. While I am extremely thankful for those businesses (paid advertisements make the recent return of *The Shopper* financially possible), I'm inspired by decades of past editions to find a way to bring *The Shopper* back to its roots. Allow me to explain. In the past, readers not only had the opportunity to see what products and services were available in the area, but they also looked forward to reading *The Shopper* to stay apprised of local happenings and life events at the personal level. You see, the *Ottawa Shopper* has always been more than just a way to advertise. Before the internet, *The Shopper* was a steady source of news and information pertaining to events and announcements such as the arrival of a new baby, wedding celebrations, birthday wishes, holiday gatherings and greetings, community services and celebrations, school activities, support for the ill, the sad departure of loved ones, and more.

In this edition I've included excerpts from pages of the August 18, 1977, *Ottawa Shopper*. For those of you who are not too young to remember 1977...I hope the excerpts bring a smile to your face. Also in this edition, you'll find a new section titled *Did You Hear?* containing current information about local happenings and life events that were recently shared publicly online by local residents and businesses on the internet. I'm certain, had the internet not been invented, this information would have landed somewhere on a page in *The Shopper*.

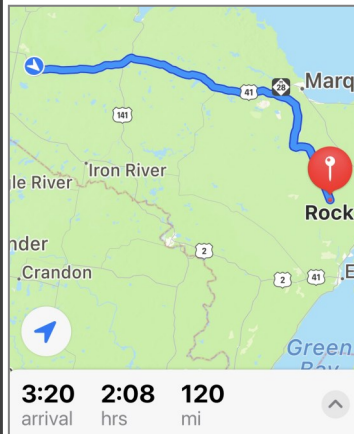


# Roadtrip!
