To say "Oh, My Bowl's Gone!" in Chippewa, say, "ON-TO-NA-GON!"

ONTONAGON is a Native American name of the Chippewa dialect and means "my bowl is gone." In the primitive days of this region, a little girl of the Chippewa nation came to the edge of the river, near where it empties into Lake Superior, with a little wooden bowl to get a drink. While dallying with it in the water, it slipped from her hand and glided off beyond her reach, when she, in her moment of excitement and sorrow, exclaimed "On-to-na-gon!" - "Oh, my bowl's gone!" From this event, the name of Ontonagon was then given by the Chippewa Indians to the river which bore away into Lake Superior the bowl of the little bright-eyed girl; and subsequently the same name was given to the village, and then the county. Like many of the rivers, villages and counties bordering on the great upper lake region where these once powerful nations of Native Americans were monarchs of the vast domain, which bear names given by them, or selected by early missionaries, voyagers or pioneers—Ontonagon is a sweet sounding illustration of the Chippewa language. If that same little girl were to visit the village of Ontonagon today, she would undoubtedly be pleased to find so many bowls.

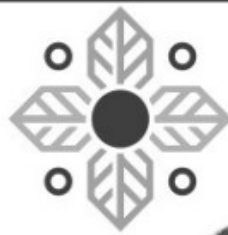
WHERE DOES THE NORTH BEGIN

The North begins-Right There.

Where the creek and rill their waters spill
As they rush to the silvery lake
Where the honking geese with their young in peace
Midst the rice in the rustling brake
Where the bull moose call in the early fall

Where the wigwam's seen beneath the hemlock green

Where the summer's sun-melt the snows that run

Where Does the North Begin is a poem from Dr. C. F. Whiteshield's book of poems *Cloverland Echoes*. His poems are based on the beauty and wonder of area countryside. From 1930 to 1943, Dr. Whiteshield was a public health officer of Trout Creek, where he was a physician and surgeon for the Weideman Lumber Co. and Duluth South Shore and Atlantic railway. His drugstore and office were in the center of Trout Creek. In 1943, in an interview on his 80th birthday, Dr. Whiteshield, also a poet laureate of the Upper Peninsula, traveler and lecturer, said: "This is my homeland. I adopted it because I love it." "Because I love it, I could not refrain from telling others about it, so that they might also enjoy its beauty and enchantment," he added. Dr. Whiteshield was a director of the Upper Peninsula Development bureau and did a great deal to arouse public interest in Michigan's Upper Peninsula. Dr. Whiteshield and his wife are buried in the Ewen Cemetery.

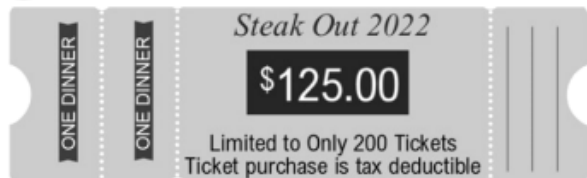
