





UNDERSTANDING THE E-TC SCHOOL DISTRICT MILLAGE PROPOSAL **BALLOT LANGUAGE**

EWEN - Please read carefully for clarification on the E-TC School District operating millage proposal included on the upcoming November

One of the proposals on the November 8 election ballot will impact the operations of the Ewen-Trout Creek School District. The proposal will ask voters to maintain the 18 mills that was approved by voters in 2016 and faces a roll back due to the Headlee Amendment. The roll back occurs when properties are sold and the assessed value of the district goes up. If approved, the vote allows the district to continue to collect the full 18 mills assessed on non-homestead property that they previously authorized . Superintendent Dave Radovich stressed that the 18 mills is at no cost to residents' homestead properties. He said a concern is the language, by law on the ballot, can confuse voters. The language includes the words "increase of 1.5 mills on non-homestead properties for 4 years." Radovich stressed the proposal actually restores millage from a decreased millage rate when a roll back occurs. He continued that if passed, the district will levy that portion of the 1.5 mills requested when a Headlee rollback occurs.

Officials also noted that to get full per student operational dollars of approximately \$9,150 the State authorizes under Proposal A, the vote is necessary.

"If this election is not successful, the district may lose funding due to a Headlee rollback in future years," Radovich said. He added that Ewen-Trout Creek voters have always been supportive of the school district and he has confidence in that continued support. The November 8, 2022, General Election includes three Ballot Proposals. McMillan Township leaders want you to know more about Ballot Proposal 22-2 "to amend the state constitution to add provisions regarding elections."

From the Ballot:

• Require nine days of early in-person voting Explanation:

The reality of this provision is that the Township (each jurisdiction) will be *required* to provide a full ballot processing venue for nine (9) consecutive days prior to election day – the two weekends and the five days in between. This means hiring a minimum of three (3) workers for eight (8) hours for nine (9) days at an hourly wage of \$12/hour. Meals will also have to be supplied, the building will have to be heated, and so on. Do the math – that's a minimum of \$2,592 in wages, plus meals, plus utility costs – and this is in addition to the cost of running the election on election day. And this would be *required for every election*.

These costs will be covered by the Townships, not by the State. McMillan Township leaders do not think this is a wise use of township funds or the time of our township clerk and election workers.
