After the recent mid-November snow storm, I stopped by the Ontonagon County Road Commission garage in Bruce Crossing to see if I could get some scoop on residential driveway plowing. I was curious as to why a County snowplow hadn't made it to our driveway after the storm. Besides that, I had heard through the rumor mill that the County might not even be plowing residential driveways any more...and I wanted to know if the rumor was true. The guys at the garage were helpful and patient with my pointed questions. Here's what I asked and learned:





I heard a rumor the County will not be plowing residential driveways this winter for financial reasons. Is that true? Not true. We'll still be plowing residential driveways



A County snowplow didn't come into the driveway after the recent storm. What happened? The County hires seasonal drivers each winter. Once they're hired on at the beginning of December, we have the mannover to add plowing driveways to the each winter. Once they're hired on at the beginning of December, we have the manpower to add plowing driveways to the list services we provide. Until then, driveways are not plowed.



How long after a storm should I expect to wait for a County snowplow to arrive to clear my driveway? It all depends. When it comes to ploying snow the main highway and highwa it comes to plowing snow, the main highways and roads are always the first priority. Our goal is to provide safe travel for as many people as possible as quickly as possible. Secondary roads and driveways are prioritized after that. When a storm drags on for days, or when the snowfall is especially high, plus blowing and drifting snow, it is more of a challenge to get (and keep) the main highways and roads clear. So naturally, it'll take a little longer to get to the secondary roads and driveways. Predicting or providing an exact timeline is not possible.



What if I'm new to the area? Do I need to do anything special to make sure my driveway is plowed? Yes, there's a one-time Driveway Permit form you'll need to complete. New residents (seasonal or part-time) can get the Driveway Permit form by stopping by the County garage. There's no charge. It's best to stop by during a weekday if possible (7am-3pm).



Do I need to do anything special to make sure the snowplow truck can get into my driveway to plow without a problem? There are a few things that residents can do to make it easier for the plow truck to do a good job. First, as soon as you know there's going to be a significant snowfall, park your vehicle(s) off to one side of the driveway or park in your garage if you have one. This makes it easier for the snowplow operator to do a clean sweep up the driveway. Secondly, make sure the plow truck can fit in your driveway. The trucks are wide, so they need around a 16-foot wide path. We also have several new plow trucks and they're several feet taller than the old ones with a new style of lights sitting higher on the top of the trucks. The lights are very expensive to replace, so ideally residents should cut back any low-hanging tree limbs or branches to help us avoid damaging truck lights.



Is there anything else residents need to know about County snow plowing? If there are certain areas where the snowplow operator should not drive or push snow then it's best to mark the border of the area (e.g., tall sticks with an orange flags) operator should not drive or push snow, then it's best to mark the border of the area (e.g., tall sticks with an orange flags).

As I was leaving the garage, I was met at the door by a lady who was delivering a plate of homemade cookies to the guys as a lovely gesture of appreciation for the work they do. I wish I had thought of that - all I brought them was a list of questions! So, in lieu of cookies, here's a public "Thank You" to the County Road Commission employees across all of our communities for the work you do every day to keep our roads safe. Please know that you are very much appreciated!



TIPS FOR COOKING GRASS-FED BEEF

healthy blood sugar levels.²

Grass-fed products cook faster than grain-fed products. To prevent burning your cut of meat, follow these cooking suggestions:

- Grass-fed beef cooks approximately 30% faster than grain-fed cuts, so use a meat thermometer to prevent overcooking.
- Make sure to preheat the grill, pan, or oven before cooking.
- Don't use a microwave to thaw out grass-fed beef. Thaw it in the refrigerator and let it sit at room temperature for 30 minutes.
- Because grass-fed beef is low in fat, coat it with avocado or olive oil to make sure it doesn't dry out.



ABOUT BLASTOMYCOSIS*

Blastomycosis is a rare fungal infection that affects human and animals. It is caused by Blastomyces dermatitidis or B. gilchristii. These fungi can be found in moist soils, particularly in wooded areas and along waterways. In N. America, blastomycosis occurs primarily in areas surrounding the Great Lakes, the Mississippi and Ohio River valleys, and the St. Lawrence River. People and animals such as dogs and cats can get blasto-

Blastomycosis is usually caused by breathing in airborne fungal spores from soil where the fungus in growing. When spores are inhaled, they settle in the lungs causing an infection, which can sometimes spread to other parts of the body. Rarely, a localized skin infection occurs if the fungus enters a cut or puncture wound. Blastomycosis is not spread person-to-person or animal-to-person. Common symptoms include: Cough, or cough with blood; Fever; Shortness of breath; Chills and/or night sweats; Fatigue; Weight loss and poor appetite. Less common symptoms may include chest, back, joint or bone pain and skin sores that don't heal. Many patients are first diagnosed with bacterial pneumonia because the symptoms are similar. See your health care provider or veterinarian as soon as symptoms appear. Let them know if you have been to an area where blastomycosis is common. Severe infections can usually be prevented through early diagnosis and treatment.






