ONTONAGON CHILDREN'S TRUST FUND (CTF) ENCOURAGES SAFE SLEEP FOR INFANTS

The Ontonagon CTF would like to remind the Community of local resources available to support families with keeping babies safe. In 2021, in Michigan alone, there were 140 deaths related to unsafe infant environments. Reported deaths often occur because of suffocation, entrapment and strangulation. To keep babies 0-12 months of age safe while sleeping at night and during naps, follow the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) guidelines:

- Place baby on back, in a crib, bassinet or pack n' play for every sleep time.
- Use a firm mattress with a tight-fitted sheet.
- Keep baby's sleep space clutter free—no pillows, blankets, bumper pads, or toys.
- Avoid covering baby's head or overheating. Instead of a blanket, consider using a sleep sack, wearable blanket or footed sleeper.
- Keep baby in a smoke-free environment.
- Remind everyone who cares for baby how to keep baby safe while sleeping.

If you are a parent or caregiver, please review your infant's sleep space, ensure that it is following safety protocols and reach out if there is a need for help. The Trust Fund has resources available to parents or caregivers that might need assistance with the goal of safe sleep. There are pack and plays, crib sheets or sleep sacks available to anyone in Ontonagon who might be in need. Additionally, "Welcome Newborn" resource bags are available to anyone who has given birth in Ontonagon to their first child. Although infant car seats are not recommended for safe sleep, **Ontonagon's CTF would also like to remind the public that there is a car seat program available in Ontonagon.** The Ontonagon CTF recently purchased a storage shed for easy access and car seat installations at the parking lot of Ontonagon DHHS and Western UP Health Department. The car seat program offered through the Office of Highway Safety is available to the public at no cost. The seat is required to be installed by a Licensed Car Seat Technician. Information on acquiring a seat or Technician appointment can be made by calling (906) 482-7382 or (906) 290-2279.

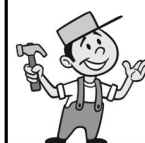
