



### YOU DON'T HAVE TO BE A DOCTOR TO SAVE LIVES

In 2018, the E-TC NHS (National Honor Society) sponsored its first American Red Cross Blood Drive which was very well-received by the community and the students of E-TC. 



### DO YOU WANT THIS?

The present draft law expires July 1, 1971.

Already, Dr. Curtis W. Tar, director of the draft, is laying plans for a new draft to take the place of the present one. He is recommending that the draft age be lowered so that 17 year olds will have to register and be subject to the draft at age 18.

The National Council to Repeal the Draft believes that conscription of men for military service is an unfair system of forced labor, that it should be resorted to only in extreme emergencies, and should be employed only after a declaration of war by Congress.

If you agree and wish to register a protest against extension of the draft by Congress, you are invited to sign a petition for that purpose. Contact in person or by phone: Mrs. Richard D. Rowley 988 2488

You need not be a registered voter to join this protest. A  $25\phi$  domation with your signature will help send delegates to Congress to present the petitions.


