pound thinly sliced cooked deli ham

1 pound thinly sliced Swiss cheese

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease a 9x13-inch
- 2. Make roll topping glaze: Mix butter, Dijon mustard, Worcestershire sauce, poppy seeds, and dried onion in a small bowl.
- Split open the rolls; place the bottom half of the rolls (tightly side-by-side) in a layer in the baking dish. Layer 1/2 of the ham onto the rolls; followed by a layer of Swiss cheese, then add top layer of remaining ham.

- You are unable to prepare nutritious meals and you have no one nearby willing or able to prepare your meals
