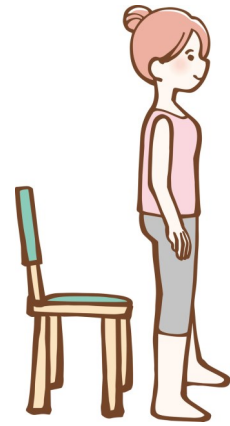

INDEPENDENT LIVING



As you age, improving your strength, mobility and balance can help you live independently longer. Here's an exercise you can do a few times throughout the day, such as when you get out of bed in the morning, during a commercial break, or any other time you get up to move about your home. This exercise will strengthen the muscles needed to stand up unassisted after sitting on a sofa, chair, or the toilet.

Sit-to-Stand Exercise (Squats): Stand about 6 inches in front of a sturdy chair with your feet between hip- and shoulder-width apart (as though you are about to get ready to sit down). Hold your arms held straight out in front of your shoulders. From here, slowly bend your knees and push your hips back to lower your bottom onto the chair. Pause for a moment, then press the back two-thirds of your feet into the floor and stand up again. Try not to swing your torso for momentum or use your hands to push back up. That motion equals one repetition (rep). Try to do two to three sets of 10 reps total per day.

TIP: Once you're able to perform two to three sets of 10 reps with good form, try doing the exercise with a lower chair or other piece of furniture.

EWEN, MI: E-TC and Watersmeet basketball fans helped the E-TC Athletics Booster Club raise \$777 for the Weaver family of Escanaba at the Watersmeet vs. E-TC basketball game on Feb. 7. The money was raised through a combination of cash donations collected at the door and a 50/50 raffle. Thank you to everyone who donated and a special thank you to 50/50 raffle winner, Tom Kolinski for donating his prize back to the Weaver family as well.

KENTON, MI: The Annual Predator Round-up, held the first weekend in Feb. had approximately 139 hunters and 8-9 youth hunters who participated. A record was made with a bobcat weight over 37 pounds. A total of 33 coyotes, 8 foxes, and 7 bobcats were harvested. Long-time hunt participant, Tim "China" Callahan was unable to join the hunt this year as he is currently in the hospital waiting for a heart transplant. The round-up attendees passed a hat around at the event to raise money for China and collected \$675. Hoppy's Bar & Grill added \$325, for a total of \$1000 to help with China's medical bills. ONTONAGON, MI: Thanks to community support, the Ontonagon Volunteer Fire Department was able to purchase 4 more Seek Thermal Imaging Cameras. The cameras help firefighters locate anyone trapped in fires/hazard conditions with zero visibility. Now, every firefighter who goes into a house fire now will have a camera on his airpack to help navigate through smoke and fire and minimize the risk of a fire fighter becoming disoriented.

WHITE PINE, MI: It looks like White Pine is busy planning their 2023 Independence Day celebration events to be held on July 28-29. Free food, bounce houses, games, 50/50, raffle baskets, live music, Warrior Weekend (all-school class reunion), plus fire-works are in the works.

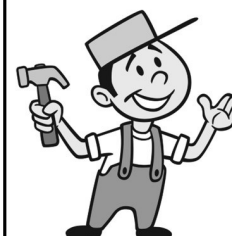
