NDEPENDENT LIVING



As you age, improving your strength, mobility and balance can help you live independently longer. Here's an exercise you can do a few times throughout the day, such as when you get out of bed in the morning, during a commercial break, or any other time you get up to move about your home. This exercise will strengthen the muscles needed to stand up unassisted after sitting on a sofa, chair, or the toilet.

Sit-to-Stand Exercise (Squats): Stand about 6 inches in front of a sturdy chair with your feet between hip- and shoulder-width apart (as though you are about to get ready to sit down). Hold your arms held straight out in front of your shoulders. From here, slowly bend your knees and push your hips back to lower your bottom onto the chair. Pause for a moment, then press the back two-thirds of your feet into the floor and stand up again. Try not

to swing your torso for momentum or use your hands to push back up. That motion equals one repetition (rep). Try to do two to three sets of 10 reps total per day.

TIP: Once you're able to perform two to three sets of 10 reps with good form, try doing the exercise with a lower chair or other piece of furniture.


