#### **General Fund Millage Proposal (Cemetery And Park Maintenance)**

Shall the Township of Stannard, County of Ontonagon, MI levy a millage of one (1.0) mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for a period of five (5) years, 2024 through 2028 inclusive, with said funds to be used for cemetery and park upkeep and maintenance. This is a new additional millage. It is estimated that one (1.0) mill would generate \$25,381.79 the first year when levied in 2024.

#### Fire Department Fund Proposal (Operation And Maintenance)

Shall the Township of Stannard, County of Ontonagon, MI levy a millage of one (1.0) mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for a period of five (5) years, 2024 through 2028 inclusive, with said funds to be used for operating and maintenance expenses for Stannard Township Fire Department. This will replace the millage (1.0 mill) that expired in 2021. It is estimated that one (1.0) mill would generate \$25,381.79 the first year when levied in 2024.

#### **WATERSMEET TOWNSHIP**

#### **Operating Millage Renewal**

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Watersmeet Township, of 3.5 mills (\$3.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value), be renewed by up to 3.5 mills (\$3.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for four years, 2023 through 2026 inclusive, for *general township operating purposes*, raising an estimated \$703,826.46 in the first year the millage is levied.


