The U.P. Wildlife Rehabilitation - Keweenaw Group posted the following on Facebook on June 6, 2023

A tale of two eagles...

Yesterday we were called by the Michigan DNR who had picked up an eagle near Escanaba. It was thought have been hit by a car. It had a large, fresh wound on the side of its chest/shoulder area but no broken bones. Copper Country

Veterinary Clinic was fantastic in getting this eagle stabilized, treated and testing done. This eagle had a lead level of 16 $\mu g/dL.^{**}$

While at the vet, another eagle arrived. This one from a nest in Baraga County. Bird banders from a Bald Eagle monitoring and banding project were banding eaglets in a nest and came across one with a broken leg. They received permission to remove



the eagle from the nest and transported it to us at the vet clinic. Once again, staff at the Copper Country Veterinary Clinic stepped right up with radiographs, treatments and testing. Blood was tested for lead and the machine just read "low"! That's a first!

**The University of Minnesota Raptor Center considers adult bald eagles with blood-lead concentrations between 20 and 60 μ g/dL as having subclinical exposure (contamination without signs or symptoms) and concentrations between 61 and 120 μ g/dL as having clinical poisoning.
