

COPPER SHORES NAMES 2023 RECREATION AND FACILITIES GRANT RECIPIENTS

- INCLUDES \$4,000 TO COVINGTON TOWNSHIP!

Copper Shores Community Health Foundation has awarded four community health grants to Copper Country institutions in response to its Community Recreation and Facilities Request for Proposals (RFP) that was released in January of 2023. The RFP specifically addressed Copper Shores' long-term sustainability goal of healthy living. Community health grants provide support for local activities or opportunities that promote healthy lifestyles which improve the overall health of a community.

Covington Township was one of four organizations selected as recipients. The township plans to use the use its \$4,000 award to replace the tow rope at the Covington Township Ski/Sled Hill. AVOID THESE COMMON MEDICATIONS WHICH ARE LINKED TO INCREASED DEMENTIA RISK

There's an important neurotransmitter that regulates your sleep cycles, muscle functioning, learning, memory, and attention. It also plays a role in regulating heart rate, gut motility, blood pressure, and the secretion of saliva, sweat, and tears. It's called acetylcholine (uh-see-toe-ko-leen) and your body makes it from choline, a nutrient contained in certain foods.

As we age, our bodies' ability to produce acetylcholine diminishes. This can lead to a gradual decline in memory recall and other cognitive abilities. **But there's a double whammy!** There are certain drugs that block your body's ability to use acetylcholine, which in turn, can accelerate problems with memory recall and cognitive abilities. These drugs are referred to as "anti-cholinergic" and some are worse than others. There are alternatives available, so it's a good idea to periodically bring all of your prescription and non-prescription drugs with you to your primary care doctor to review each of them to make sure you're taking the safest and most effective drugs for your aging body and mind. Here are just a few examples (this list does not include every possible drug) of anti-cholinergic drugs that are known for accelerating problems with memory and cognition or causing drug-induced dementia:

- **Antidepressant/ Anti-anxiety:** amitriptyline (Elavil), imipramine (Tofranil), nortriptyline (Pamelor, Aventyl), paroxetine (Paxil), belladonna (Donnatal)
- **Anti-spasmodic/ Anti-convulsant/ Stomach cramping/ Nerve pain:** dicycloverine (Bentyl, Dicylomine), carbamazepine (Tegretol, Curatil)
- **Sleep/ Allergies:** diphenhydramine (Benadryl, Nytol, Sleeppeaze, Unisom)
- **Urinary Incontinence:** darifenacin (Enablex), fesoterodine (Toviaz), oxybutynin (Ditropan XL, Gelnique), solifenacin (Vesicare), tolterodine (Detrol)
- **Acid reduction (PPIs):** lansoprazole* (Prevacid), rabeprazole* (Aciphex)

FOODS HIGH IN CHOLINE

Choline is an essential nutrient and a building block of acetylcholine. Foods naturally high in choline include whole eggs, meats and fish, navy beans, broccoli, and green peas. Studies in laboratory animals and humans suggest that consuming foods or supplements rich in choline may elevate levels of acetylcholine in the brain.

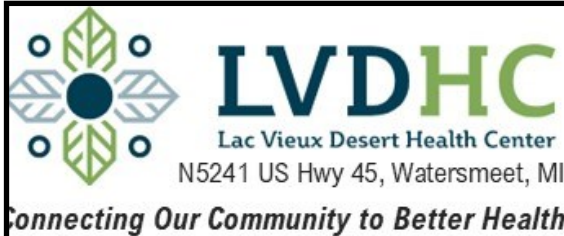

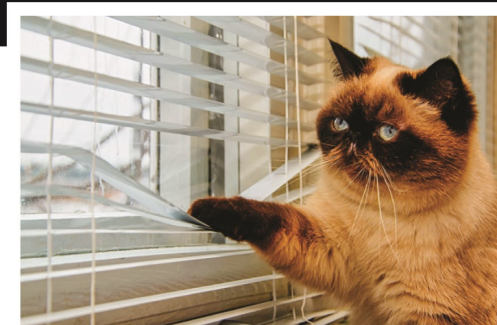
