

AS HEARD FROM A LITTLE BIRD

MARENISCO: Fishtales Bar & Grill on Lake Gogebic has a new owner! Stay tuned.

COVINGTON: Area residents and travelers who frequently pass through the Covington junction continue to express their sadness and dismay over loss of the North 141 Travel Center/Mini-Mart/Gas Station in Covington (corner of M-28 and US-141), which burned to the ground last month. After running the popular travel shop for nearly 27 years, the owners sold the business to a young newcomer earlier in the Summer. Customers were quick to notice (and quick to make comments on Facebook) that the shelves were mostly bare throughout the summer and that alcohol was no longer sold due to the new (underage) owner not having a liquor license. The Michigan State Police fire investigation unit inspected the site in the days following the fire, but the cause of the fire is not yet announced. Be sure to plan your fuel stops accordingly if you're traveling this route across the U.P..

WHITE PINE: On July 24, 2023, Highland Copper Company announced the results of preliminary economic assessment (PEA) and a mineral resource estimate for what it calls "White Pine North" (the former White Pine Copper Mine). The economic assessment projects the mine would provide an excellent return on investment The announcement also introduced Kinterra Copper USA as Highland's new "joint venture" partner. Kinterra gave Highland \$30M. In return, Kinterra now has a 66% stake in the White Pine North project. BUT, that money can be used by Highland as needed for making progress toward the ultimate goal of mining production at either White Pine North or Copperwood (Highland's other mining project in the Wakefield area). The next steps for keeping the White Pine North project moving forward include obtaining all the necessary permits, performing infill drilling, and then conducting a feasibility study. Notably, Kinterra has committed to investing an additional \$30M to support these next steps ("to advance the project"). One highlight directly from the mineral resource estimate for White Pine North projected a mine life of 21.8 years, including 21 months of ramp-up, with average annual (for the life of the mine) payable copper production of 93.5 million pounds and 1.2 million ounces of silver.





This young raccoon was found wandering around outside an apartment complex. He was very friendly and approaching people, some signs that he was either sick, or raised by humans and now too used to people. When we got there to assess the situation, we found him healthy looking, well-nourished and quite easy to contain. This was indicative of a raccoon that was raised as a pet. The pads on his feet are burned from walking around on hot payment for however long he did. It is quite probable that he was raised by people and then left out alone after he grew up to be a teenaged raccoon.

He spent all day and night crying. He doesn't know he is supposed to be living a wild life as a raccoon, not as a pet for people. He will now have a ridiculously hard time "wilding up" and getting ready to be released. There are about a hundred reasons NOT to keep and raise baby raccoons if you find them. Now this poor guy is suffering because someone thought that they could have a pet then dump him after he got to be too much. It is heartbreaking and frustrating.

Please contact us if you find a baby animal. Before ever feeding it, deciding to keep it as a pet, or thinking you can raise it for your kids then abandon it when he grows up. This guy has no idea how to be a raccoon and it is not fair to him.




