





SEPTEMBER CONSERVATION DISTRICT MEETING SUMMARY

The Ontonagon Conservation District held its regular monthly directors meeting on Monday, September 11, 2023 in Rockland., MI. Present were board directors, Heather David, Valerie Talsma and Sara Baciak, district manager Anne Kretchmann, USFS Mark Menigoz, and Guests and prospective Board Member Charle and Grace Burger from Bohemia Township. The regular meeting was suspended for the board to go into a special session on appropriates and the 2024 budget. Appropriations were approved as presented, The 2024 Budget was amended to increase funding to "community promotions" and the amended budget was approved. The special session was then adjourned and the regular board meeting resumed.

The Gogebic Co. Forester position was added to the Agenda. Under Community Public Comments, Charle Burger introduced himself as a candidate for the open Board Seat. In the partner / director reports, Mark Menigoz, USFS spoke of RAC. The Ottawa National Forest has one Secure Rural Schools Resource Advisory Committee (RAC) that is chartered by the USDA. A Secure Rural Schools RAC provides recommendations to the Forest Service on the development and implementation of special projects on federal lands as authorized under the Secure Rural Schools Act and Community Self-Determination Act in Public Law 110-343. This act was most recently reauthorized for two years by section 41202 of Public Law 117-58 (Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act) and signed into law by President Biden on November 15, 2021. Once the committee is seated, the \$600+K grant monies for projects in the Ottawa National Forest will become available.

Under new business, bills were paid, the MOU/MOA for the appropriations were signed and the Board agreed to fund local advertisements for the Gogebic Co. Forester Position as that professional also serves Ontonagon County.

Old business: the Board recognized the petitions and signatures of two candidates for

the two open board positions. Sarah Baciak, interim appointment, McMillan Township, and Charle Burger, Candidate from Bohemia Township.

No other action was taken on Old Business Items due to time & temperature constraints.



ONTONAGON CO./GOGEBIC CO.: Local municipalities were recently notified of new grant money awards they will receive from the state through the Protecting Michigan Pension Grant Program (Public Act 166 of 2022, Section 979a). This is a state-created grant to aid underfunded Michigan employee retirement systems (MERS) for cities, villages, townships, counties and road commissions. A partial list of local municipalities receiving the awards are includes: Ontonagon Co. Road Commission Road \$ 2,968,071; Village of Ontonagon \$ 1,952,964; Gogebic Co. How to Slow Down Time: Science behind stopping life from flying by

Why does time seem to speed up as you age? Part of the reason time seems to speed up as we age is due to our perception. According to neurologist and neuroscientist Dr. Santosh Kesair, "For a 60-year-old, one year is less than two percent of their lives. We gauge time by memorable events and fewer new things occur as we age to remember, making it seem like childhood lasted longer."

As we get older the world becomes more familiar, we learn less, and we fall into the habit of turning towards information and experiences that fit within what we already know instead of trying new things. There's less adventure, play, exploration, creativity, and wonder to find newness.


"Time is this rubbery thing," says neuroscientist David Eagleman. "It stretches out when you really turn your brain resources on, and when you say, 'Oh, I got this, everything is as expected,' it shrinks up."

In other words, when you experience or do something familiar, your brain isn't processing new information, so later on, your memory of the experience is shortened (making time seem constricted).

But, when you are acquiring new knowledge, or having new experiences. your brain tracks the new things and creates memory "anchors" - so when

you look back at the experience there is more to recall, making is seem like time was more stretched out. To mold your perception of time, so that it feels less like life is flying by, try something new as often as possible. If it ends up being something you really enjoyed it may even feel like it didn't last long enough while you're in the moment. However, when you look back on that period

later, time will

seem to have lasted much longer because of the memory anchors your brain created with each new experience.


