Have you ever noticed and mounds on the Ottawa National Forest? Most appear to b Have you ever noticed the large tional Forest? Most appear to be made by the Ulke's Mound Ant (Formica ulkei). The mounds can

be up to 8 feet wide and 2.5 feet high, and are filled with tunnels and cavities that are home to thousands of ants. The ants cover their mounds with a layer of thatch, especially white spruce and balsam fir needles. The thatch protects the mounds from rain and keeps the nest from getting too hot in the sun. The species was described in 1893 by the Italian Entomologist Carlo Emery, who named the species after Titus Ulke, who collected samples while working as a minerologist for a mining company in South Dakota. Never sit on one of these ant mounds. The ants will defend their home vigorously, biting with their mandibles and injecting formic acid from their abdomens.
