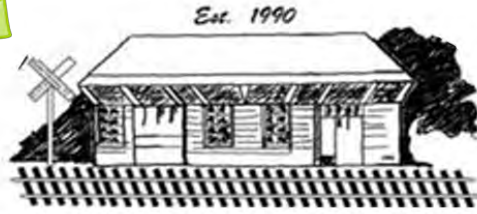

2024 MICHIGAN DNR FISH STOCKING - LOCAL WATERS

In 2024, the DNR stocked 9.1 million fish consisting of 10 different species and one hybrid. Fish stocking provides Michigan residents and visitors with quality fishing opportunities. These efforts also bring an estimated \$4.2 billion into the state's economy and help support a Great Lakes fishery valued at more than \$7 billion. Fish are reared in Michigan's state fish hatcheries anywhere from one month to 1.5 years before they are stocked in state waters during the spring and summer.

MASS CITY: Merritt's Travel Center has new owners and the name has changed to Mass City BP.

ONTONAGON & GOGEBIC COUNTIES: If you own land, then Parker Wohlstein, our new local Forester for Gogebic and Ontonagon Counties, is someone you need to know. His state-funded position is

focused on providing small land owners with a wide suite of assistance. He can help you enroll in various programs like the "Qualified Forest Program" - property tax incentive program. He'll even stop by your property to help you figure out things like: *How many decomposing trees should I leave standing for wildlife habitat? What are these insects? Should I slash back my acreage? Where's the best spot to grow berries? How can I improve maple syrup production? What trees make the best deer habitat? Could I plant a Christmas tree farm?* You can contact Parker at 906-285-1497.

U.P. COUNTIES: West Nile Virus, which is carried by infected mosquitoes, has been detected in several U.P. counties. Protect yourself from mosquito bites! The virus spreads when a mosquito bites an infected bird and then bites a person. Mosquitoes carry the highest amounts of the virus in late summer and early fall. Avoiding mosquito bites is your best defense.

MICHIGAN DNR FISHING REPORT

August 7, 2024

Keweenaw Bay/Huron Bay: Anglers reported successful jigging and trolling trips. Anglers who chose to jig found lake trout and lake whitefish, and had the greatest success in the morning, using natural baits. Anglers who were trolling found salmon and lake trout all through last week. Earlier, anglers found more fish near the lower portion of the water column, but as the week continued and a south wind was present, more fish were caught in the top 50 feet of the water column.

Traverse Bay/South Portage Entry Canal: Anglers were jigging and trolling with some success. Trolling anglers found Chinook salmon, coho salmon, brown trout, rainbow trout and lake trout. Successful fishing trips occurred during all times of the day but were most heavily concentrated in the mornings. Anglers who were jigging found fish on the edges of drop offs and were most successful using cut bait.

Ontonagon River: Fishing was good on the river last week. Anglers reported successful trips throughout the day with a preference for early mornings. Walleye were also reported. Anglers had more success jigging than trolling.

Ontonagon/Silver City/Union Bay: Lake trout were caught in good numbers, with occasional coho salmon also being reported. Anglers had the best luck in finding fish when trolling deeper waters.

Black River Harbor: Angling efforts were low in the harbor last week, contrasting high recreational boating. Average reported catches were of lake trout in fair numbers, primarily found by anglers while trolling deeper waters.
