



Naloxone (NarcanTM) is a life-saving medication that can reverse opioid overdoses. Narcan is an opiate antidote which works in much the same manner as an epinephrine injection (EpiPenTM) reverses an allergic reaction. Opioids include heroin and prescription pain pills like OxyContinTM, PercocetTM, methadone and VicodinTM. When a person is overdosing from an opioid, their central nervous system and respiration system is depressed and breathing slows or stops.



Naloxone blocks the effects of opioids and reverses the effects of an overdose.

All community members are welcome to attend, and no prior experience is required. Narcan training is offered free of charge and takes approximately one hour to complete. After completing training, attendees will receive a free Narcan kit that can be administered in the field and save a life. Registration is not required, but recommended. 



Winter is Coming

Provide shelter: Keeping a pet outside for long periods of time is not recommended, but if you're unable to keep your dog inside during cold weather, provide him/her with a warm, solid shelter against wind. Make sure that they have unlimited access to fresh, **non-frozen** water (by changing the water frequently or using a pet-safe, heated water bowl). The floor of the shelter should be off the ground (to minimize heat loss into the ground) and bedding should be thick, dry and changed regularly to provide a warm, dry environment. The door to the shel-

ter should be positioned away from prevailing winds. Space heaters and heat lamps should be avoided because of the risk of burns or fire. Heated pet mats should also be used with caution because they can cause burns.

OTTAWA SHOPPER JUNE 2024 - SURVEY RESULTS

Dear Reader: In June 2024, you were asked to share your news communication preferences and feedback regarding the content and frequency of the Ottawa Shopper. As expected, since an all-reader survey was conducted once before in 2023, (before the circulation was expanded to include all of Ontonagon Co.), the majority of responses in this most recent survey came from north Ontonagon County readers. Most received last month were via the mail (~80), with close to a dozen more received via email.

Of the 91 surveys received, 88 of the responses indicated either satisfaction with the frequency of this newsletter (every 2 weeks) or a desire to increase the frequency of delivery to weekly. The majority of respondents DO listen to one of the local radio stations - mostly WUPY 101.1 (in the morning), followed by several mentioning 107.5, 94.5 WRJO, 91.1 WGGL Houghton, MN Public Radio. Respondents also indicated that Facebook is either infrequently used (1x/day to 1x/week) or never used as a source of information.

Suggestions under the category of, "What would you like to see More of" included topics such as hunting & fishing photos, restaurant and food information, and local school information. One respondent indicated they would like to see "Less of" the publisher's personal information. More on that topic in a future edition. Lastly, additional comments were overwhelmingly posititive, kind, and supportive. Thank you to everyone who took the time to respond. 
